



## Authorization to Release Information

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (or FERPA, 20 U.S.C. §1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of certain educational records. At age 18, FERPA rights transfer from the guardian to the student. As a result, there is limited educational information that \_\_\_\_\_ can discuss with anyone other than the student directly.
